

Information clause in higher education admission process:

In accordance with the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data - General Data Protection Regulation (Journal of Laws of the EU L 119/1 of 4th May 2016) I inform that:

1. The Institute of Physics of the Polish Academy of Sciences is the Administrator of your personal data, i.e. entity that decides on how your data will be used, and it's represented by the Director with his seat in Warsaw on Al. Lotników 32/46. You can contact the Administrator using one of the forms of contact that are available on the website: phone: (22) 116-2111 e-mail director@ifpan.edu.pl
2. Director of the Institute of Physics of the Polish Academy of Sciences appointed the Inspector of Data Protection (IOD), who can be contacted in matters related to your personal data. You can contact the Inspector by emailing to the address: iodo@ifpan.edu.pl
3. Your personal data shall be processed for the purpose of carrying out higher education admission process;
4. Consent for processing of your personal data is a legal base for processing of your health data (uniform text: Journal of Laws of 2017, item 2183);
5. Your personal data shall be processed for the period of 6 months from the moment of finalisation of the admission process, and in the case you are admitted, data shall be processed for the period that lasts the same as the course of the studies, after that it shall be archived in accordance with the applicable law;
6. Your personal data shall not be shared with other recipients except for the entities entitled by the virtue of law. Employees and members of admission committees authorised by the administrator shall have access to your data.
7. Sharing your personal data is voluntary, but in the case you do not agree to share it you will not be granted full access to the admission process;
8. You hold the right to have access to your data, to rectify it and to limit its processing;
9. You hold the right to file a complaint to the Inspector General for Personal Data Protection if you find that processing of your personal data infringes the provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation.
