- Your personal data shall be processed for the purpose of enabling full participation in the higher education admission process in accordance with the provisions of the Higher Education Act (uniform text: Journal of Laws of 2017, item 2183) and the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities adopted on 13. December 2016 (Journal of Laws of 2012, item 1169);
- 4. Consent for processing of your personal data is a legal basis for processing of your health data;
- 5. Your personal data shall be processed for the period of 6 months from the moment of finalisation of the admission process, and in the case you are admitted, data shall be processed for the period that lasts the same as the course of the studies, after that it shall be archived in accordance with the applicable law;
- 6. Your personal data shall not be shared with other recipients except for the entities entitled by the virtue of law. Employees and members of admission committees authorised by the administrator shall have access to your data;
- 7. Sharing your personal data is voluntary, but it the case you do not agree to share it, you will not be granted full access to the admission process;
- 8. You hold the right to have access to your data, to rectify it and to limit its processing;
- 9. You hold the right to file a complaint to the Inspector General for Personal Data Protection if you find that processing of your personal data infringes the provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation.
